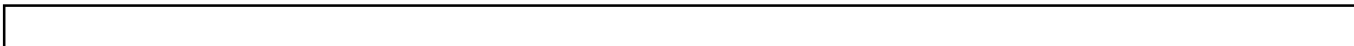

## PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

The Parish Council met on Wednesday 3rd May, 2006.

There was no representation from the Police but Rona Burt, from the District Council attended.

The issues discussed were

- A new Chairman and Vice-Chairman were elected -Wendy Goult as Chairman - congratulations to you Wendy - and John Browning continues as Vice-Chairman. Claire Devlin remains as a Parish Councillor.
- Playing field - The Alice Dix Charity have agreed to fund the reseeding in the Autumn.
- Funding for play equipment - Grants have been submitted.
- West Street Lighting - Will be started as soon possible.

- Producing the newsletter - This is to be printed by a local company with a slightly different format which we hope will be acceptable
- Prescription Collection - Jean Padmore has offered this service in West Street and Ronnie Halford (717715) can be contacted for prescription collection in the rest of the village.
- Pearl Watson has agreed to continue as Parish Clerk -on behalf of everyone we would like to say how happy we are that she is not resigning - we certainly would have missed you Pearl.

## RECIPE OF THE MONTH

### APPLE CAKE



8oz Self-raising Flour  
 4oz Butter (softened)  
 4oz Soft Brown Sugar  
 8oz Dessert Apples (cored and chopped)  
 2 Eggs (beaten)  
 2 teaspoons Cinnamon  
 2 tablespoons Soft Brown Sugar and a good pinch of Nutmeg/Cinnamon for top of Cake

Sieve flour and cinnamon, rub in butter, add sugar, apples and eggs. Stir to stiff dough. Spread in 9" greased lined tin, Sprinkle with sugar/spice topping. Cover with greaseproof paper and bake in oven for 30 mins at 350 F / 170C.  
 Delicious, served with a cup of tea on a sunny afternoon!

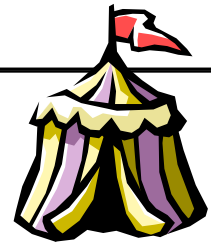
