

The system is extremely flexible, allowing the police to send you appropriate messages, based on the details you provide when you register.

You can register up to three postcodes. So you could have your home, workplace and the address of a relative.

This means that if the police receive information about burglars operating in an area where you have a vulnerable relative, we can send you a message, so that you can make any necessary arrangements to ensure their safety.

The system has the capability to send up to 3,000 messages in just one minute, or up to 200,000 in an hour.

Receiving messages is FREE

To stop receiving SMS text messages text STOP to 88588 at any time to de-register from this service.
