Another busy year for the Village Hall Committee in fund raising.

The number of Hall lettings are up in number although not in income. The Carol Supper was successful and raised more funds than previously and our thanks must go to the W.I. for arranging the buffet supper.

The Community 100 Club improved again on previous years by raising £927, each to the Village Hall and the Church.

Special thanks to the Chairman for his Quiz Nights and to Roy Jones for arranging the Eastern Angles Theatre Co.

Apart from the above mentioned events, we are finding it very difficult to gain the support for various other fund raising. We are not getting the backing from the Village and have had to cancel at the last minute.

The major donations gratefully received were from the Carpet Bowls Club, The Gun Club and the WEA, and special mention and gratitude to the Barrel Fair and the W.I. in generously donating in support of our Grant applications.

In the matter of our maintenance and upgrade of the Village Hall, we are indebted to John Babbington for his hard work and the winning of various grants to make our venture in the renovation of the toilets at last possible.

Our income this year has been boosted by these grants and the work is now in hand, due for completion by the first week in June. No major expenditure has yet been made showing a large balance still in hand in the Charities Account but when final payment is made, expected during June, our balance in hand will be down to approx £3,000 in the Building Development a/c.
