Both applications below were GRANTED, but had conditions applied.

Location – Cavell Cottage, Church Lane, Blythburgh

Proposal – Erection of replacement summerhouse.

Location – High Lodge Shooting School, Darsham Road, Blythburgh

Proposal – Erection of building for indoor Air Pistol and Air Rifle range

Application No. C/08/0877

Location – Land adjacent 1 Stone Cottages Walberswick Road, Blythburgh

Proposal – Retention of 2 caravans for pig stockmen's accommodation

The Parish Council recognised the need for the accommodation and wished to support local enterprise. The Parish Council also considered that the conditions under section AP-31 and AP-33 of the Local Plan are in part met and so supports the application with the following conditions;

- The application, if approved, is given for a limited time, preferably for 1 year but a maximum of 2 years, to ensure the requirement for the caravans is reviewed at a minimum of every 2 years.
- The approval of the application is for temporary accommodation only and does not become a pre cursor for a permanent residence.
- The requirement for a septic tank is reviewed as the Parish Council are only aware of one individual currently living in the caravan's.
- Building of a 'screen' to minimise the visual impact of the caravan's.

- The caravans are only used for the stated purpose so will stay empty out of the pig breeding season.

08/28. Update on situation with Community Speedwatch Campaign.

Currently five of the six applicants have completed the Police vetting and the sixth is expected to complete soon. Cllr Lewis is still chasing the Police over the signs and speed gun. Suffolk Police were surprised by the outcome of a recent ‘trial’ of speedwatch in Ipswich even with the target of 38mph set. It is looking unlikely that the campaign will be up and running before the Latitude festival.

08/29. Update on the Latitude Festival.

A bus service running to and from the festival has been arranged between the festival organisers and Anglian Buses. Timetables will be provided with the tickets.

Additional tickets have been secured for Saturday to shorten the waiting list. It is planned to contact those who have requested tickets 3-4 week prior to the festival.
