- Please collect entries from the Fayre after 4pm .

2. All Entry Forms must be completed and received, together with the correct Fee by the date stipulated on the entry form. Any cheques must be made payable to "Debenham & Helmingham Benefice".
3. All Horticultural and Handicraft exhibits must be in place in the Show Marquee at Crow's Hall by 11am on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> May. On entering the Marquee each exhibitor will be issued with entry cards which must be displayed face down with every exhibit.
4. All exhibitors must vacate the Marquee whilst judging takes place. This will be completed by 12 noon
5. The Judge's decision is FINAL. The show committee cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to the exhibitor's property
6. The show committee reserves the right not to award a rosette if there are insufficient entries in a particular class
7. Rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> place and certificates for 1<sup>st</sup> , 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places.
8. Entries may be collected from the Marquee anytime after 4pm on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> May.
