

Postal Scam

Although this originated in time for Christmas, it has been confirmed by Royal Mail that the Trading Standards Office are still making people aware of the following scam:

A card is posted through your door from a company called PDS (Parcel Delivery Service) suggesting that they were unable to deliver a parcel and that you need to contact them on 0906 6611911 (a Premium rate number).

DO NOT call this number, as this is a phone scam originating from Belize.

If you call the number and you start to hear a recorded message you will already have been billed £315 for the phone call.
