THE RULES

All exhibits must be in the Village Hall between 9.30am- 10.30am
on the day of the show with entrant's form and fee.

Items are to be collected between 4.30pm - 5.00pm on that day.

All exhibitors must live in Polstead.

Every exhibitor must be the grower/ baker/ artist etc. of the exhibit.

No more than one entry in any class per exhibitor, e.g. only 1 Garden on a Plate per person but you could also enter for the Biggest Sunflower head.

All exhibitors shall provide their own vase/ plate/ box etc. with their name labelled underneath or discreetly and be collected afterwards.

Food must be protected with a transparent cover.

All home-grown exhibits must have been in the possession of the exhibitor for not less than 8 weeks prior to the show.

The judge's decision will be final.

Although every possible care will be taken of the exhibits, the Polstead Gardening Club cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage arising from any cause whatsoever.

The show will be open to the public from 2.30pm- 4.30 pm on that day.

All exhibitors must be aged 16 or under, please state their age on the entry form.

- j. Hand made birthday card- 8 years and under.
- k. Hand made birthday card- 9 years and above.
