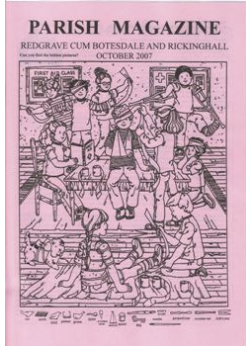


PARISH MAGAZINE



Redgrave Parish Magazine is delivered to all dwellings in the three villages in our benefice, namely Redgrave, Rickingham and Botesdale. The magazine is published ten months of the year, and we aim to have copies through letter boxes by the first day of the month. We have a print run of 1225 copies with spare magazines available from Redgrave Cross Keys and Botesdale Post Office.

The magazine is "free to reader" and is funded by our commercial advertisers, without whom we would not have such a successful publication.

Local voluntary organisations and residents may advertise non commercial events taking place in the villages free of charge.

The magazine contains articles of local interest contributed by some of its readers. Subjects include: village history; ornithology; news from each of the three parish councils; herbal medicine and events that take place in a village hen run. Village organisations and individuals also provide reports of events and their successes in fund raising. There is a calendar of forthcoming events and we publish details of church services held by all denominations.
