The planning advisory group used the planning application documentation to provide those present with an overview of the site as is and as proposed. The planning advisory group had visited the site as this was a large application. Cllr Mackley introduced the application highlighting areas of importance. Cllr Waller presented the environmental aspects of the application and stated that the environmental report was very poor. He also highlighted areas where conservation gains could be made. S Boggis then summarised the pluses, employment and financial input, and the minuses, increased traffic and potential impact on local infrastructure, should this application be successful. Councillors questioned the group and added suggestions as the application was explained. The outcome was that the Parish Council objected to the location of 5 lodges, were unhappy about the environmental report and survey but overall were supportive of the scheme.
