Over £600 was raised for Village Projects. Thanks to all the committee who gave so generously of their time and resources!

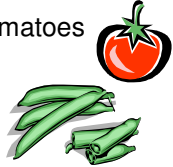

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Tomato and Green Bean Salad

8oz mixed baby yellow and red tomatoes
 8oz thin green beans
 Handful of chopped green mint
 1 clove of garlic
 4 tbs of extra virgin oil
 1 tb of balsamic vinegar



Method

- * Cut tomatoes in half and place in large bowl
- * Blanch beans in a saucepan of boiling water for 2 minutes, then drain and place in the bowl with Tomatoes
- * Add the chopped mint, garlic, olive oil and balsamic vinegar. Season with salt and pepper and mix well.
