RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Sophie's Krispy Squares

- 3 Mars Bars
- 1/4 cup of butter
- 2 cups miniature marshmallows

In the Garden



- ◆ Keep weeds in check - don't forget "one years seeding means seven years weeding"
- ◆ Border carnations can now be propagated by layering. Pinks can be increased by taking "pipings". These are the tips of growths approx. 2" long pulled out and inserted in boxes of sandy soil
- ◆ In the Flower garden stake and tie plants, dead head Roses regularly, feed hanging baskets and tubs
- ◆ Lift early Potatoes, select suitable ones for seed if the stock was new this year. Do not expose to light - put in a cool place
- ◆ Tender plants can be moved outside to take advantage of the sunlight
- ◆ Take time to sit and enjoy the garden
