Introduction

The Village Hall makes an ideal venue for community groups, public events, private parties, weddings, conferences and commercial enterprises. It has recently been extended and the facilities have been refurbished to a very high standard. It has a main hall, lounge area, meeting room, stage and changing / dressing rooms for hire. A large car park is provided. The layout is designed so that the hall and rooms can be used together or independently with separate access if required. The main hall can be booked for morning, afternoon and or evening sessions and other rooms can be hired on an hourly basis. A large playing field is located adjacent to the hall and can be hired by arrangement.

Facilities

Main Hall

The main hall refurbished in 2008 measures 58ft x 24ft with a dark



hardwood floor. The room is light and airy and is equipped with stage lighting, a mirror ball for dancing, complete with "loop", sound and public address systems. There is a large 15ft x 12ft projection screen & a small retractable projection screen to one side of the hall.

The number of people that can be accommodated will depend upon the function and layout but as a guide the main hall can seat up to 120 people for dining and 150 people for concerts.

The hall has a large selection of tables including 6 large circular banqueting tables that can each seat up to 10 people.

Kitchen

The kitchen, opened in 2004, measures 17ft x 12ft and routinely serves 70 hot meals at the Luncheon Club.



It is equipped with a double sink, twin ovens, dishwasher, microwave, fridge and hot cupboard. Crockery and equipment are stored in cupboards below the large food preparation surfaces. Between the main hall and the kitchen is a 7ft x 4ft serving hatch with shutter.

Conference Room

The community room, opened in 2005, measures 21ft x 18 ft with an oak



hardwood floor. The room can seat up to 30 people for meetings. The room is equipped with a sink, fridge and tea and coffee making facilities. It has a white board and retractable projection screen. Broadband connection can be provided by contacting the GB Computer Club. The room can be hired together with the main hall or independently.

Stage

The stage measures 24ft x 13ft with a recently refurbished oak floor. It is equipped with stage lighting and easy access from the changing rooms via two staircases on the L.H.S. of the stage. There is another staircase which

provides access to the R.H.S. of the stage from the kitchen.

The Annexe

The annexe, which is adjacent to the main hall, is accessed via 4 pairs of sliding doors. Opened in 2009 it measures 47ft x 18ft and is equipped with a servery. It can be used as a lounge area in conjunction with the main hall with 40 club chairs, 10 stools and 12 coffee tables, or it can be used as a self contained meeting room for up to 60 people.



Changing Rooms

There are 3 changing / dressing rooms, with power showers in two rooms. A store-room serves as an additional changing room if required.



Renewable Energy

The building is heated by a ground source heat pump and has a photovoltaic system for energy generation.
