Location: 10 East view, Dunwich Rd, Blythburgh.

Proposal: Erection of first floor extension, rebuild existing conservatory & creation of pedestrian access.

Location: 38 Blyth View, Bulcamp, Blythburgh

Proposal: Insertion of two new windows in rear elevation

Location: River Blyth Estuary, Blythburgh, later changed to Walberswick

Proposal: River wall reinstatement in Blyth Estuary

It was explained that this application covers 8km of river wall in Walberswick. The EA has accepted the consultant's report that the river is silting and their argument is not valid. All other agencies and land owners support this application. However it will take a long time to complete (up to 10 years). It was felt this would not impact Blythburgh. The Parish Council had no objection to this application.
