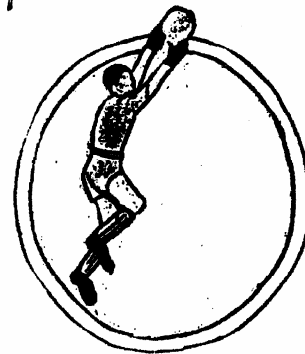
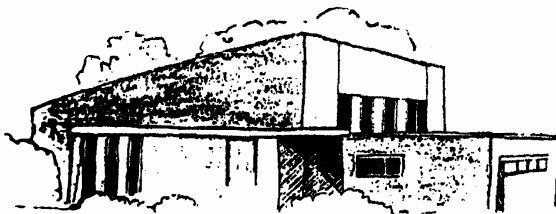

KEDINGTON COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION (K.C.A.)

The Community Association is run by a Council which includes representatives from most village organisations. We provide and maintain the Community Centre and the Great Meadow in Arms Lane, (near the Barnardiston Arms public house). These facilities are used by many organisations and the Centre can be hired for wedding receptions, private parties etc.

In addition the KCA contributes to the enjoyment of life in Kedington by organising social activities such as the Meadowlark events in June each year. Among the KCA sections are the Ketton Players Drama Group and the 3K's and Freaky Haze Junior Drama Groups, Carpet Bowls Club and Noah's House Community Café.

The KCA publishes The Ketton Review magazine on a quarterly basis. There is also the Village Ernie which is a monthly cash-prize draw for those taking part. (You have to be in it to win it)

EMERGENCIES

Most domestic incidents are best served by calls to plumbers, electricians etc but for more serious incidents requiring quick response, then call 999 for Fire, Police, Ambulance or Coastguard (not really applicable in Kedington but you might be visiting coastal areas).

More serious occurrences, such as widespread flooding or pandemics etc. that might be labelled "disasters" require the implementation of special arrangements by one or more of the emergency services, the NHS or the local authority.

To help combat the effect of emergencies, there is a body of men and women involved in Emergency Planning. Organisations prepare for emergencies by having plans for either site-specific or hazard-specific incidents. Major emergencies could be: storms, flooding, major transport accidents, environmental pollution and even in these days, acts of terrorism.

If you are a witness, **dial 999** and alert the emergency services. If you are stranded in your home, tune in to your local radio or television station for advice.

Pass on any warnings to neighbours and check on the elderly or disabled if safe to do so.

In cases of serious emergency, **GO IN, STAY IN, TUNE IN**
