

What is NIGHTSAFE?

Nightsafe is a local multi agency partnership co-ordinated with the Police and is aimed at improving the quality of Public night life throughout Great Yarmouth.

Working with partner agencies such as Fire, Ambulance, CCTV and the local Council to name but a few we are leading the way to ensure you have an enjoyable and safe night out in a Town that can offer so much.

We will improve on every element of your night out, including your journey into the Town, the places you frequent such as Pubs and Clubs, the services you receive relating directly to your personal safety.

The route you travel during the evening, food outlets you visit and safe passage out of Town at the end of a good night out will all be covered by Nightsafe.

Why NIGHTSAFE?

Research into violence in the night-time economy consistently shows the peak time for violent offending is weekend nights and locations are situated in and around pubs and clubs (Allen et al., 2003).

Tackling the problem by using existing good practices around the night-time economy we formed a partnership under the 'Nightsafe' Banner. We have been able to gain widespread co-operation from core group businesses and agencies to improve

your night out.

With Nightsafe partners, alcohol and drug related disorder will **not** be tolerated **anywhere** in Great Yarmouth.

Great Yarmouth's Pubs and Clubs serve **drinks** and not **drunks**.

Nightsafe aims to remove the elements that can spoil a really good night out for so many.

How will NIGHTSAFE affect my night out?

If you enjoy a good night out with your friends, then everything Nightsafe stands for will only serve to better your night out.

You will notice the Nightsafe logo displayed at Pubs and Clubs in the Town. These indicate Nightsafe partners and they are devoted to ensuring you have an enjoyable safe night out.

As a condition of entry at Clubs you may be subject to a routine search, but this is to ensure that sharply pointed objects and illegal substances can not be present while you are out to enjoy yourself.

If you live in the Town then you will probably already know about the CCTV system that has cameras recording incidents 24 hours a day. CCTV is also a Nightsafe partner and via a direct radio link between partner Clubs, the Police and CCTV we are better equipped to identify and deal with disorder than ever before.

The Police will also patrol the Town with mobile CCTV recording equipment to record and identify anyone set on spoiling a good night out so

don't be alarmed we are here to help **you**.

At various locations are leaflets containing information on responsible drinking practices to help you make informed decisions about alcohol and drugs. There is after all nothing worse than being refused service or having to tell your mates "**Don't overdo it**".

You may also notice information at food outlets and within the Towns Nightsafe partner transport network-buses, trains and taxis, aimed at helping you and your "**friends stick together**". Let us help you have a good night out and "**get home safely**".
