**RECIPE OF THE MONTH**

**LEMON CRUNCH PIE**

75gm (3oz) Butter  
 150gm (6oz) Digestive biscuits (crushed)  
 397gm can sweetened Condensed milk  
 2 eggs (size 3) separated  
 Juice and rind of 2 lemons  
 100gm (4oz) castor sugar)

Pre-heat oven to 190C, 375F, Gas Mark 5  
 Melt butter, stir in biscuits. Press into base and sides of fluted 8" flan dish.  
 Beat together condensed milk, egg yolks, lemon juice and rind.  
 Pour over biscuit base.  
 Whisk egg whites until stiff then gradually whisk in sugar.  
 Pile on top of filling in flan case

Bake for 15-20 minutes until meringue is crispy.

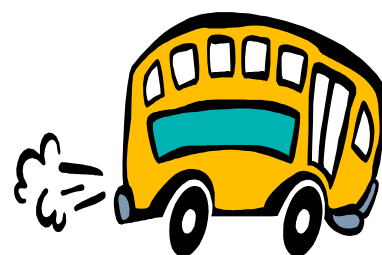
**BUS SERVICES IN THE VILLAGE**

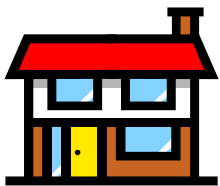
