## The Village Green

It has come to the notice of the Parish Council that certain misinformation is being circulated around the Village concerning The Green. The Parish Council would therefore like to take this opportunity to put the record straight.

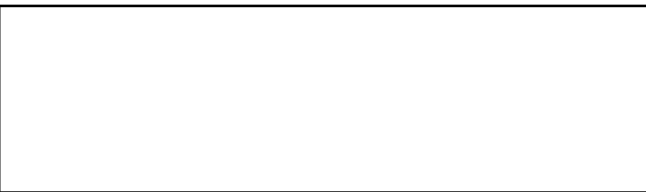
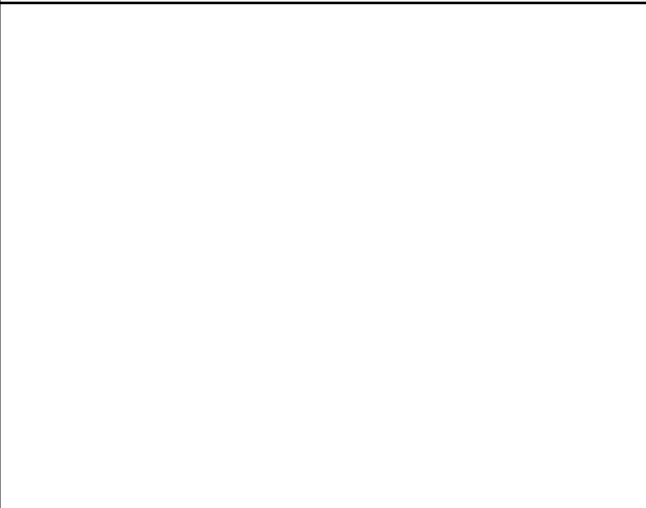
The Green is currently classed as Common Land having been designated Manorial Waste for which the Council has the responsibility for its upkeep and maintenance for the good of the residents. To enable the Parish Council to accomplish this in a more structured and efficient manner we have applied to Register the Green with Suffolk County Council and this is currently in progress.

In order to preserve its unique character and to ensure it is retained as a pleasant area and attractive backdrop to the church, shrubs were added some time ago. **THERE ARE NO PLANS TO INSTALL A FENCE** which according to the current myth, would completely encircle The Green. Such an idea would be against Parish Council policy and is totally without foundation.

There are no plans to prevent public access to The Green or All Saints Church, in fact the Council welcomes visitors to the area and has done all they can to ensure there is parking available for those wishing to visit the church. Church Cottage is one key holder and the Plough have agreed to act as a key holder as well and hopefully some agreement could be reached with the landlord for the use of their car park.

There are preliminary plans to define the boundary with the highway by the introduction of a line of low posts and chain link and will not prevent public access over Footpath No. 1

We can only guess at the motivation behind this misinformation but it can only be to breed mistrust and suspicion and cannot be for the common good. We would assure you the Parish Council will continue to work toward ensuring Icklingham remains a pleasant place to live and would do nothing to detract from the enjoyment of your surroundings
